




Corona Virus Testing at School

The health care support workers will help me with the test. They will keep me safe.




I will clean my hands with the hand sanitiser and then I will blow my nose. People will help me if I need it.




The test will be a swab at the back of my mouth. I will move the swab around the back of my mouth three times on each side.

This might feel uncomfortable. That is okay. It will not hurt. The test is to keep me safe.



When I am finished I will go to back to class. My teachers will tell me if there is anything I need to do next.
